

Fabrizio Piras graduated in Experimental and General Psychology in 1999 and obtained his Ph.D. in cognitive Neuroscience in 2005 at Sapienza University of Rome. His research interests fall within the field of the neural basis of cognitive disorders in neurological (stroke and neurodegenerative diseases) and psychiatric conditions (schizophrenia, mood disorders, obsessive-compulsive disorders) by means of behavioural measures and MRI analysis. In particular his skills include brain morphological mapping, volumetry, cortical thickness analysis, diffusion tensor imaging, lesion-behavior associations as well as functional MRI. He authored more than 60 articles published in highly impacted peer-reviewed international journals as well as book chapters in the field of neurology, psychiatry, psychology, molecular biology and neuroimaging.

Fabrizio Piras has been junior research leader in the Neuroimaging Section of the Neuropsychiatry Laboratory at Fondazione Santa Lucia of Rome and contract professor of Neuropsychology at University of Chieti Gabriele D'Annunzio.
